Guardian-Teacher Interaction Meeting (Parents/Guardian)

The Institute needs to associate the parents/guardians in its collective effort of continuous improvement of the qualities of education and academic environment. Accordingly, Guardian-Teacher Educator interaction sessions will be held periodically to share mutual experiences about the broader and their academic performances.

GENERAL RULES FOR THE USE OF LIBRARY

1. The student teacher has to undergo two days induction training on the MITT. He / She will expose to the vision and mission of the institute, class and campus conduct, do and don't in Labs. and Library and interaction with all teacher educators and staffs. It is mandatory to all student teacher.
2. Library Hour: 9 A.M. to 5 P.M. To accomplish the library assignments, other readings and transaction of books.
3. Users must have the Library Card with them whenever they use the Library.
4. Library Card is not transferable.
5. Maximum borrowing of documents: A maximum of three books can be borrowed for a period of fifteen days. In addition, one periodical and one CD/DVD may be borrowed by all students for three days.
6. Student teacher has to give sufficient reason of late return books/any document to library.
7. If card is lost: Rs.50/- has to be paid for procuring a duplicate card.
8. For damage of document: (A) Minor damage: 10% of the cost of documents has to be paid.(B) Major damage: 25% of the cost of documents has to be paid.
9. Photocopying services: Rs.2.00/- for each page. Services would be available in a specified time of a working day.
10. Silence must be maintained inside the library. Students found unnecessarily seated in groups and gossiping in the library will not be allowed to stay there in any case. For any incidence of defiance in this regard the student or students concerned will forfeit entry into the library and his / her/ their card/ cards will be seized.
11. Cell phones should not be in use within the library.
12. Reference books are strictly confined to library and are not issued for home use.
13. Documents should be thoroughly checked before leaving the counter. No complaint would be entertained afterwards.
14. Any constructive comment or suggestion for improvement of the library service will be thankfully received. Users may give it in the feedback register or drop their written comments in the suggestion box.
15. Notice Board should be followed for information that may be given from time to time.
16. College ID card is mandatory to enter to the library.
17. Expression of ideas in any form after reading the books will be encouraged and disseminated to all students.
18. Any material contribution of student teachers to library will be received cordially.

No Ragging

As per directive of the AICTE under National Ragging Prevention Project, all the aspirant candidates along with their parents/guardians are advised to go to the website WWW.ANTIRAGGING.IN or WWW.AMANMOVEMENT.ORG and fill up and submit the Affidavits online and take a printout of the submitted Affidavits (both student & parent) and submit the same to the Institute Officials while taking their admission in Madhusthali Institute of Teacher Training.

Ragging is neither a ritual nor a custom in campus life. It is a punishable criminal offence. Madhusthali Institute of Teacher Training strongly discourages ragging and stringent action is taken against offenders. All new students are welcome to join Madhusthali Institute of Teacher Training without any fear or apprehension.

"Ragging" means the doing of any act which causes, or is likely to cause, any physical, psychological or physiological harm or apprehension or shame or embarrassment to a student, and includes:-

1. Teasing or abusing of, playing practical joke on, or causing hurt to, any student, or
2. Asking any student to do any act, or perform anything, which he would not, in the ordinary course, is willing to do or perform; and "student", means a student who has been prosecuting his studies in an educational institution.

Section 3:

(1): Ragging within an educational institution is hereby prohibited.

(2): No person shall participate in, abet, or propagate, ragging in any educational institution.

Explanation: For the purposes of this section, educational institution shall include:-

1. the premises or the campus of the educational institution, or
2. the hall, that is to say, the unit of residence of students maintained by the educational institution, if any, or
3. the hostel, that is to say, the unit of residence for students, if any, not maintained by the educational institution but recognized under any law for the time being in force.

Section 4:

Whoever contravenes the provisions of section 3 shall be punished with imprisonment of either description for a term which may extend to two years, or with fine which may extend to five thousand rupees, or with both.

Section 5:

If any student is convicted of an offence punishable under section 4, he shall be dismissed from the educational institution in which he has been prosecuting his studies for the time being, and shall not be re-admitted to that educational institution.

Section 6:

Without prejudice to the foregoing provisions of this Act, where a student complains of ragging by any other student to the head of the educational institution or to any other person responsible for the management of the educational institution, such head of the educational institution or person responsible for the management of the educational institution shall forthwith inquire into the complaint and if, on such enquiry, the complaint is found to be true, he shall expel the student, who has committed the offence, from the educational institution.

The Supreme Court Verdict against ragging

- Ragging in any form is a criminal offence and hence the ragging offenders to be treated by Police and the Court of Law, on a par with any other criminal under Indian Penal Code.
- Once, after probe, the accused is charge sheeted by the police, courts will fast track the ragging cases.
- Consequently, ragging offenders to be given stern and exemplary punishment. One such punishment will be summary expulsion from the institute and forfeiture of future claim for admission elsewhere.
