Library Rules And Regulation

- ◆ Only registered members are allowed to use the library.
- ◆ Users must have the library card with them whenever they use the library and library card is not transferable.
- ◆ Silence must be maintained inside the library.
- ◆ Use of cell phone is strictly prohibited inside the library premises.
- ◆ Readers are not allowed to bring personal books, printed materials and personal belongings like bags, umbrellas, etc. Inside the library.
- ◆ Reference books are strictly confined to library use only.
- ◆ Duration of book issue for the students is 02 (Two) books for 15 (Fifteen) days and for teachers 03 (Three) books for 21 (Twenty one) days. In addition one periodical (Back volume) and one CD/DVD can be issued for a period of 3 (Three) days.
- ◆ Library can take back any issued book even before the due date if needed.
- ◆ For damage of document : (A) Minor damage : 10% of the cost of the documents has to be paid. (B) Major damage : 25% of the cost of documents has to be paid and for (C) book lost / severe damage (Not readable condition) : twice of the print rate of the book / document will be charged/the charge is subjected to library authority.
- ◆ Documents should be thoroughly checked before leaving the counter. No complaint would be entertained afterwards.
- ◆ If library card is lost : Rs 50/- (Fifty) has to pay for procuring a duplicate card.
- ◆ Library after having the approval of the Library Committee/Principal may change or modify any of the library rules.

Academic Rules & Regulations

- ◆ *The working days should be at least 200 days in an academic year as per NCTE & JAC recommendations.*
- ◆ *Each student must have to attend the 36 working hours in a week.*
- ◆ *All academic transactions either of theory or practical / skill / fieldwork have equal weightage on designing academic calendar.*
- ◆ *There is unit as well as monthly test procedure to track the progress of the each pupil teacher.*
- ◆ *All the curricular transactions inside the classroom will directly linked to institute situations and followed by feedback of students from classroom teaching, if possible, the community members. The curriculum transactions of the class rooms will be consolidated and bridge with field work will be always appreciated.*
- ◆ *Encourage seminar, articles, workshop, lecture and other academic forums will be encouraged in the light of multi- disciplinary, innovative and activity oriented and child friendly approach.*
- ◆ *Action research on the part of pupil-teachers and faculties will also be encouraged.*
- ◆ *Academic representation in any academic forum of college on teacher education on the part of students and faculties will be encouraged in the cost of quality parameter and thrust of Institute.*



Code of Ethics

- ◆ The College starts from 10:00 a.m. and continue up to 4.00 p.m. on all the six days of a week to ensure more than 220 working days in a session. Besides Seminars, Cultural activities, sports, teaching practice and other projects, assignments and community engagement are planned from time to time, separate notices for which are issued.
- ◆ Pupil-Teachers are advised to be present in the institute campus sharp at 9.45 a.m. with necessary reports/teaching aids. Since classes start at 10.00 a.m. students entering late in a particular class may be liable to be marked absent.
- ◆ Pupil-Teachers must strictly adhere to the dress code of the Institute. Breach of Dress Code will be treated as gross indiscipline on the part of the student for which he/she may be liable to be punished in such manner as may be decided by the Institute authority.
- ◆ Pupil-Teachers must follow the 'Academic Calendar' and prepare themselves to do the best in different activities of Calendar.
- ◆ 90% of attendance is compulsory in Practicum and 80% in Theory for each Pupil-Teacher to appear the final exam.
- ◆ Late coming in class will not be allowed in anyway.
- ◆ Appearing at unit test, monthly tests, peer learning activities are compulsory.
- ◆ During outside project work/practical work and team work, students will be subjected to rules and regulations of the school/organization where they are deputed. Students should follow these rules and regulations and keep their supervisors/teacher-educators posted with the progress, made on the project. The Norms and standards set by the supervisor/teacher educator need to be strictly followed.
- ◆ Use of Cell Phones at classes, labs and the library is strictly prohibited. Pupil-Teachers using cell phones must switch them off before entering classes, labs and the library.
- ◆ Non-submission of Project Reports/Teaching Records will debar the Pupil-Teacher from conducting the next experiment.
- ◆ All the labs follow certain safety and academic Norms for their smooth functioning. Pupil-Teachers are advised to keep themselves updated on those Norms and must follow them accordingly.
- ◆ Innovations/suggestions are highly solicited. Pupil-Teachers are requested to use idea box or disseminate the same using Notice board.
- ◆ Publication of any form of idea will be encouraged in the institution.
- ◆ Institute may plan for action researches on teacher efficiency, evaluation of learning performances, development of teaching learning materials etc. where Pupil-Teachers have to acquire it.
