



SCHOOL INTERNSHIP

The duration of practice teaching for D.El.Ed. 1st & 2nd year was 30 days and for B.Ed. 1st & 2nd year, it was 18days and 120 days respectively.



SUPPORT OF ALLOTED SCHOOLS DURING SCHOOL INTERNSHIP

District Education Office, Deoghar and District Superintendent of Education, Degoghar allotted 16 schools of conduction of School Internship program of 200 B.Ed students and 100 D.El.Ed students in two phases. Schools like S.P.M High School, ADH School, UHS Pandania, MLG, Madhupur, Patrol HS,UMS of Lalgarh, Pathalchapti, Sapaha, Bherwa, Suggapahari, Paharpur, Salaiya and PS, Salaiya were allotted for the same.
