REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATION :

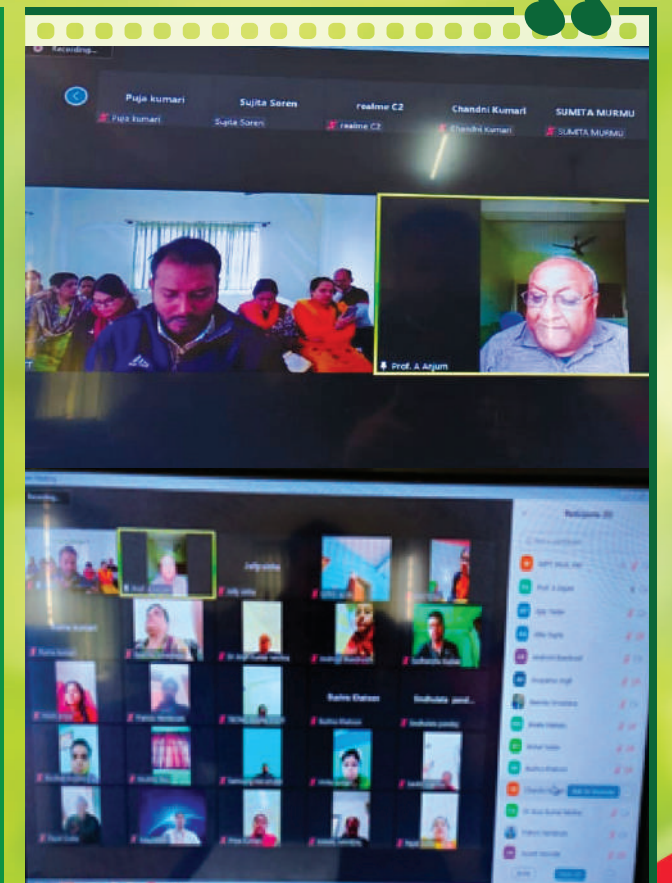

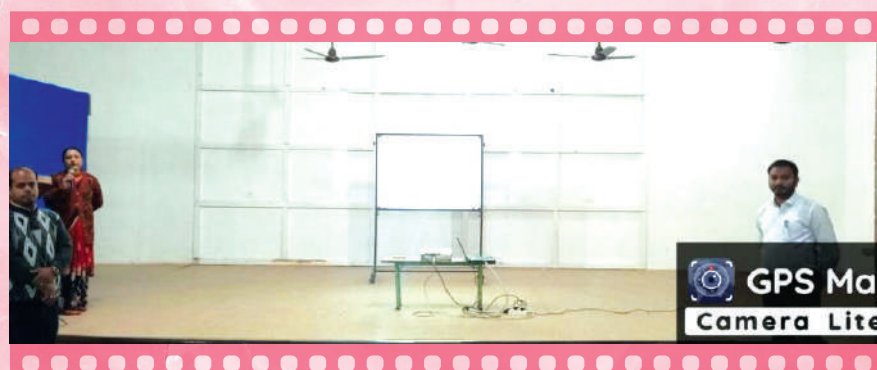
WORKSHOP ON LANGUAGE TEACHING SKILLS:

MOTIVATIONAL SPEECH BY RJDE, DUMKA :

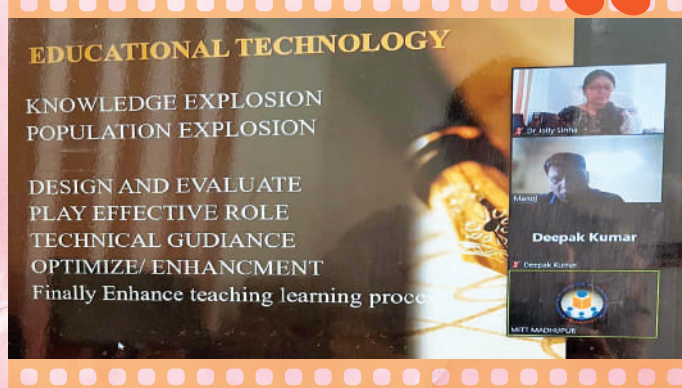
