Discussion & Resolution

1. Review of SSR

Any necessary changes or additions will be made before the final submission. The committee emphasized the importance of timely submission to maintain the institution's accreditation timeline.

2. Feedback of work status of different committees

The Chairperson invited each committee to provide an update on their assigned tasks and responsibilities. Feedback was given on the status of projects such as curriculum development, faculty training, research initiatives, and student support services. Several committees reported progress, while others indicated the need for additional resources or guidance. The Chairperson recommended that committees facing challenges should reach out for support, ensuring all tasks are completed efficiently. Regular updates were requested to monitor ongoing progress.

4. Plantation of trees under best practice

5. Concession of fees of girls' students


The Chairperson introduced a proposal to provide fee concessions for female students should continue, especially those from economically disadvantaged backgrounds. The committee discussed the benefits of this initiative in promoting gender equity and increasing access to education for women. It was agreed that criteria for eligibility would be established and communicated to the students. The Chairperson instructed the financial committee to explore how best to implement this initiative while maintaining the institution's financial stability.

6. Curtailment of holidays during summer vacation

The Chairperson proposed shortening the summer vacation to accommodate the extensive work required for the NAAC accreditation process. The reduced break would allow faculty and staff to focus on completing necessary documentation and preparations for the assessment. The committee agreed, acknowledging the importance of prioritizing NAAC work. A revised vacation schedule will be prepared and communicated to all stakeholders to ensure smooth planning.

7. Review of practice teaching programme

The Chairperson called for a review of the current practice teaching program to assess its effectiveness in preparing student-teachers for their professional careers. Feedback from student-teachers, mentor teachers, and the partnering schools will be collected to identify areas for improvement. The committee agreed that enhancing the mentorship program and incorporating modern teaching strategies into the practice sessions would strengthen the program. A detailed review report will be prepared, and any recommended changes will be implemented in the next academic cycle.
