1. Status of SSR (Self Study Report)

2. Quality initiative

Implementing quality initiatives in teacher training colleges is crucial for preparing educators to meet modern education demands and contribute effectively to student learning. Key considerations include curriculum review and development, pedagogical training, technology integration, practical teaching experience, assessment and evaluation, inclusion and diversity training, research and innovation, feedback mechanisms, accreditation and quality assurance, and community engagement. Curriculum review and development should align with contemporary standards and practices, while pedagogical training should focus on student engagement, active learning strategies, and effective classroom management. Technology integration should equip colleges with modern educational technology to enhance student learning experiences. Practical teaching experience should be emphasized through internships, student teaching, or practicum placements and mentorship programs should be implemented. The chairperson requested to IQAC committee to be more focused on such things in upcoming days.

3. More linkage and MoU

The chairperson also informed the committee that Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) and linkage between colleges and other organisations can greatly improve the opportunities and overall educational experience for faculty and students. Thus, we must strengthen the MoU in addition to these links.


4. Guidelines from university IQAC coordinator

For better guidance, the IQAC coordinator recommended that the chairperson speak with the IQAC coordinator at the university.


5. IIQA submission
